- 4) Must follow all OSHA regulations while on premises.
- 5) Must only remove equipment identified and approved by Hilco
- 6) Must not remove equipment or anything that is considered part of the building or Belonging to the landlord. All air conditioning and plumbing fixtures must remain in their present location.
- 7) Contractors are not allowed to operate Lowe's equipment and must provide their own forklifts.
- 8) All mechanical equipment brought into location other than a forklift will need Hilco approval. Any equipment brought in the warehouse and damages the floor, Contractor will have to repair and needs inspection/approval from Landlords.

Doors:

All Doors including metal roll-up or overhead must remain in good working condition.

Traffic:

 During the Equipment removal process, traffic in and around the building must always be able to flow in a normal manor.

Roof (There will be no removal of anything on the Roof)

 All AC units will stay intact. All damage to ducting or vents coming down from the roof will be repaired at contractor expense.

Sprinkler (Lowe's will perform all disconnects in bay for all sprinkler drops)

• Any sprinkler lines damaged by Contractor must be fix at Contractor expenses.

Electric (Lowe's will complete all disconnects on all Electrical)

All Wiring must be capped inside the nearest covered junction box. If junction boxes are not
present, then add a covered termination box. All electrical work must be completed to local codes.

Pallet Racking or Cantilever Removal

- All pallet racking or cantilever must be dropped down and banded. All Floor Bolts must be cut off at floor level. If removal of floor bolts damages the floor, then Contractor must repair.
- Buyer must sweep area after removal and leave in a broom clean condition.
- Buyer may not abandon any Pallet Racking or Cantilever.
